

CHOOSING A DEGREE PROGRAM CAN BE A CHALLENGE. ON THE BACK, YOU WILL SEE ALL THE DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES THAT WE OFFER AT LASSEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE. The questions on this page may help you decide.

- **❖** Associate of Arts Degrees (A.A.) and Associate of Science Degrees (A.S.) are both 2-year degrees that require completion of 60 units of transfer level coursework.
 - We offer twenty one A.A. and A.S. degrees which are specifically designed for transfer to a 4-year school
 - Some are "terminal A.A. degrees" meaning they are not designed to prepare you to transfer.
- **Certificates of Achievement** are awarded for 18 to 42 units of degree-applicable coursework.
- **Certificates of Accomplishment** are awarded for degree-applicable coursework ranging from 6 to 17 units.
- ✓ Step 1: Think about whether you want to transfer: If you are fairly certain you want to transfer to a 4-year school after your time at Lassen College, narrow your choices to one of the degrees that says "for Transfer" or "University Studies". These degrees are designed to prepare you to transfer to a 4 year school.
- ✓ Step 2: Choose an area of interest: Think about what you are good at, what you enjoy doing, subjects in which you have excelled in high school, what interests you, or what career you might want to pursue.
 - Do you enjoy **History, English, Biology, Geology,** or **Economics**? Consider pursuing a degree in those areas. We have other degrees in areas that might not be as familiar to you. Such as:
 - **Natural Science** is the study of the natural world through courses such as plant and animal science, biology, chemistry, geology, physics, astronomy, and human anatomy & physiology
 - **Social Science** is a broad field that studies humans through courses in history, anthropology, economics, psychology, and political science
 - **Humanities** is the historical study of music, art and literature
 - **Psychology** is the study of human behavior, as well as human development
 - Anthropology is the study of humans, past and present
 - Sociology is the study of humans in societies how we relate to one another in groups
 - Do you have an aptitude for art or design? Consider Art History or Studio Art
 - Do you want a marketable skill that can translate into a job? Consider Welding or Automotive Technology
 - Thinking of a career in corrections, law, or law enforcement? Consider Administration of Justice
 - Do you enjoy the business of agriculture, or animal science? Consider our Agriculture degrees and certificates.
 - Thinking of the medical field? Consider Allied Health, Biology, Medical Assisting or Vocational Nursing
 - Do you want to work with or teach young children? Consider Child Development or Early Childhood Ed.
 - Are you interested in some aspect of business? Consider our Business degrees and certificates
 - Want a career in gunsmithing? Consider applying for our Gunsmithing Program and then working toward the general education requirements for the degree
 - Like the idea of fighting fires? Consider Fire Technology
