

Description:

This course prepares or enhances the ability of first time supervisors through provision of information on evaluating and reporting incident conditions, analyzing incident needs, developing and implementing a plan of action to deploy incident resources completing all operations to suppress a wildland fire, establishing an incident command post, creating an incident action plan, and completing incident records and reports.

This course is designed for experienced Fire Fighters seeking the rank of Company Officer.
