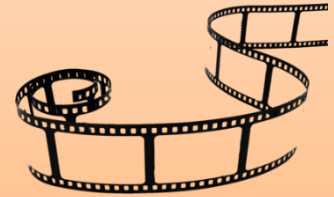


**The Lassen Community College
