This course is designed to train firefighters and emergency medical personnel in low angle rescue techniques. Students will learn about equipment identification and care. Note: students must provide their own safety equipment which will include: long pants, long sleeve shirt, and work boots with aggressive soles for traction on steep slopes. Students may re-enroll in this course for credit as legally mandated to meet training requirements as a condition of continued paid or volunteer employment. Additional state certification fee applies.

Note: Must be 18+ to register for this class

Space is limited. If you are not immediately registered in the class be sure to include yourself on the waitlist.

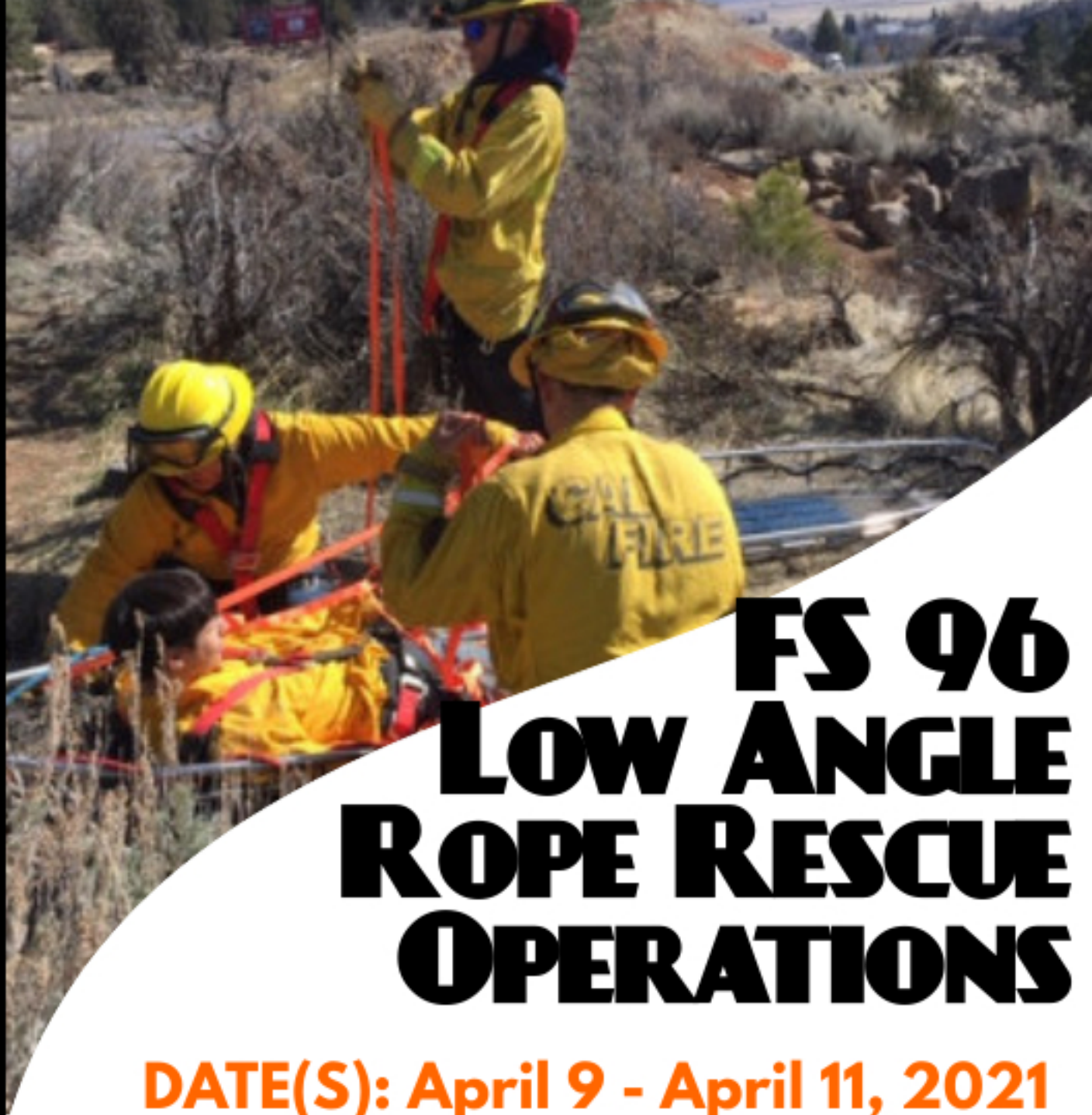
