

Residency

Any person enrolled in Lassen Community College is subject to the residency requirements determined by the Education Code of the State of California. In order to establish residence, it is necessary that there be a union of act and intent. If you believe you meet the criteria for establishing California residency, documentation must be provided. [California Non-Resident Tuition Exemption](#) – In accordance with the law passed by the California Legislature in 2001 AB 540 exempts certain nonresident students, who have attended high school in California and received a high school diploma or its equivalent, from payment of nonresident tuition. Contact the Admissions & Records Office for more information on this exemption.

International Students – An International student is a non-immigrant who is in this country on an F-1 or M-1 visa and who plans to return to his or her home country upon completion of his or her studies. Military Personnel Residency – Applies to certain individuals of the military who are present in California under military orders, except those assigned to California for educational purposes. Contact the Admissions & Records Office for more information on this exemption.

Nevada Tuition Reduction Program (Good Neighbor Policy)

Students who wish to attend under the [Nevada Tuition Reduction Program](#) must provide proof of Nevada residency by presenting a drivers license or documentation showing physical address. This program is open to all Nevada Residents who wish to attend Lassen Community College. Consideration is given on a first come, first serve basis. Approximately one hundred students are admitted through this program each fiscal year. Petitioning for this reduction does not guarantee registration.
