

TUITION & FEES

Students may pay fees by cash, check, Visa, or MasterCard. Payments may be made on WebAdvisor, or they may be mailed to Lassen Community College, Atten: Business Office, P.O. Box 3000, Susanville, CA 96130. There will be a *\$25 handling fee charged on all returned checks.

ENROLLMENT FEE

Spring 2008

California Residents

*\$20 per unit (no maximum per semester)

Section 72252 of the Education Code requires Lassen College to charge an enrollment fee of each student enrolling in college. The fee is *twenty dollars (*\$20) per unit per semester for resident students.

If at the time of enrollment you are receiving benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), the Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Program, or the General Assistance Program, the enrollment fee will be waived (The student is responsible for the Health Fee and Student Rep Fee). For information on the procedure for requesting a waiver, contact the Financial Aid Office before you enroll at Lassen College.

Non-Resident Tuition Fee

Out-Of-State Residents - *\$183 per unit + *\$20 per unit enrollment fee + the health fee and student rep fee.

Out-Of-State Residents taking 6 or fewer units - *\$42 per unit + *\$20 per unit enrollment fees + the health fee and student rep fee

Nevada Good Neighbor Policy - *\$42 per unit enrollment fee + the health fee and student rep fee.

Foreign Citizens - *\$183 per unit + *\$20 per unit enrollment fee + the health fee and student rep fee.

*Fees are subject to change at anytime.

What is the Student Rep Fee? The Student Rep Fee of \$1 will provide support for students or representatives who state positions and viewpoints before City, County, and district governments, and before offices and agencies of the state and federal government. (You may for religious, political, financial, or moral reasons refuse to pay the Student Representation Fee).

What is the Health Fee? The Health Fee is \$7.50 for full-time students and \$5 for part-time students. During summer sessions, this fee is \$5 for full-time students and \$3.50 for part-time students. Health fees are not refunded except in the incident of a canceled course. Some students may be exempt from the health fee. For information and specifics, contact the Lassen Community College Financial Aid Office.
