2023-2024 Elliot Dow Memorial Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible applicants include graduating high school seniors planning to attend Lassen Community College (LCC), current LCC students and past LCC students that have transferred to a four-year school. Recipients may be awarded for multiple years upon application if student maintains a 2.5 GPA and is registered as a full-time student (12 unit minimum). Preference will be given to current or previous LCC students planning to pursue a four-year degree in Agriculture.

Students who receive this Scholarship are encouraged to apply for it each consecutive year while pursuing a four-year degree. Upon completion of a four-year degree, a cash award will be awarded to students who qualified and received this scholarship at the junior college and university level.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

The scholarship award is for the 2023-2024 academic year (one year). The amount is determined based on eligible applicants and the scholarship selection committee. The scholarship is for tuition; books purchased at the college bookstore; student fees (ASB, health, etc); and dormitory fees. Successful award recipients will be required to submit official documentation signed by the school's registrar confirming enrollment. Scholarship funds will not be released until this documentation is submitted. The scholarship award will be distributed by semester (quarter) upon proof of enrollment.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

\$750 – High school seniors or current LCC students planning to enroll or currently enrolled at LCC.

\$1,000 – Solely intended for former LCC students now enrolled full-time in an agriculture degree program at a four-year school.

DEADLINE:

<u>Applications must be submitted by June 30, 2023</u>. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. All applications must include an unofficial transcript from applicant's High School or College.
- 3. Check box at end of the application confirming you have read and understand the scholarship's terms and conditions.
- 4. All applicants must submit a resume highlighting school activities, awards and achievements, community involvement and work experience.
- 5. All applications must include one current signed letter of recommendation. Letters may be submitted from a teacher, college professor, community member, employer, pastor, etc.
- 6. Successful award recipients will be required to submit official documentation signed by the school's registrar confirming enrollment. Scholarship funds will not be released until this documentation is submitted. Awarded funds must be claimed during the following academic semester or quarter.
- 7. Receive a confirmation email from the Lassen College Foundation.
- 8.
