- LCFA A tentative agreement with the district has been reached. One major LCFA concession was preparation and submission of student learning outcome assessments. Faculty cannot be evaluated on content of assessment results only on completion and submission. In return, the district agreed to restructure the salary schedule from thirteen steps to ten. Hourly salary (adjunct and overload) will now be \$37.27 and top of scale salary will now be \$80,319.
