Minutes

Action

- 1. Approve foreign degree transcript evaluation language for inclusion in the Minimum Qualifications and Equivalency Handbook. (Beterbide/Giampaoli MSCU) MQ Chair Gardiner explained this is a necessity as there is an increase of applicants submitting foreign transcripts without foreign transcript evaluations.
- 2. Approve Curriculum Action Log for Fall 2013 and forward it to the Board *President Aschenbach has reviewed the Action Log and made corrections to make Log consistent with Curriculum Minutes.*

Discussion

1. Digital Graphics Design IPR (2014) – 1st reading Lori Collier is to be commended for her early submission of the Digital Graphics Design IPR. President Aschenbach has provided Ms. Collier with feedback and it is anticipated that a final revision will be ready to forward to the Board of Trustees in January 2014.

2. Gunsmithing IPR $(2013) - 1^{st}$ reading

Accreditation Chair Mouck expressed concern regarding an IPR moving forward without a comprehensive curriculum review, which is exacerbated by the previous (2011) IPR not containing a comprehensive curriculum review. President Aschenbach concurred. President Aschenbach will work with Gunsmithing faculty to include curriculum review with IPR.

3. Changes to Annual IPR Update timeline (Aeron Zentner)

The outcome of extended discussion about IPR Update timelines and IPR timelines was a recommendation to inform faculty of the benefit of early submittal of IPRs or IPR Updates as applicable to the budget process, specifically in regards to budget requests being

It was identified that providing a visual showing timelines involved with budget cycle be included in IPR Handbook. Language clarifying these issues will be included in Handbook update with no change to due dates of documents.

4. AP 4104 Contract Education

Discussion included a desire to draft an AP that was comprehensive and specific enough to identify regulatory requirements for contract education for both apportionment generating and non-apportionment generating courses, including those identified by the Federal Department of Education. Outside of meeting regulatory standards, AP language should be broad enough to allow flexibility.
