- 3. AP 5520 Student Discipline Process: Dean of Students Patrick Walton explained in detail the process by which students can appeal disciplinary action, and how the process has been implemented. Walton, along with Swanson and Nyman, who both serve on the Campus Discipline Committee, answered questions regarding objectivity, transparency, and fairness in carrying out the appeals process.
