 Identification of Recommendations from Evaluation of Planning and Governance (Consultation) – Cheryl Aschenbach Four recommendations were discussed last week:

- a. The need for research data to better inform planning decisions
- b. The need to continue to improve communication. Consider a webbased calendar with all meetings scheduled and explore linking agendas/minutes to the calendar. Also, groups are encouraged to use a program like Doodle to help figure out when more members are available.
- c. The addition of the Direction of Institutional Effectiveness to Consultation Council/Strategic Planning Committee
- d. The need to include the written evaluation process for planning and governance into the Institutional Planning and Collegial Consultation handbooks

Consultation Council agreed to forward these recommendations to the subcommittee tasked with revising the Budget & Planning Process Handbook.
