AEBG Program Areas

1. Adult education (ABE, ASE, Basic Skills) and programs leading to a high school diploma or equivalency.
2. English as a second language programs, citizenship and workforce preparation.
3. Pre-apprenticeship training that coordinates with recognized apprenticeship programs.
4. Career and technical training that is short term programs with high employment potential.
5. Adults training to support child school success, primarily to develop knowledge and skills in schools.
6. Older adult programs related to entry or reentry into the workforce.
7. Programs for adults with disabilities.
