Tool List for Checkering Class

This tool list contains specific tools that will make learning to checker easier and not waste your money on items that are not necessary.

Tools:

- 1,60 degree veiner (Ullman)
- 1, 60 or 75 degree fine or medium single line cutter
- 1, 90 degree fine or medium cutter
- 1, two line cutter in 20 or 22 L.P.I.
- 1, three line cutter in 20 or 22 L.P.I. (LPI must match the 2 line cutter)
- 1, Concave boarder cutter
- 2 5 straight single bar handles for the above cutters such as Gunline H-2 handles
- OR Steve Earl full view handle

I recommend the above standard length (3/8") cutters from Gunline, Ullman Precision

or Steve Earl.

NOTE: Do Not get any 2 or 3 line cutters with one smooth edge

- Long Swing Arm work lamp
- Super Sharp Scribe (not carbide) You can make one from 1/8" drill rod or stiff spring wire
- Marks-On-Anything pencil (I like white) Brownells #347-125-600
- Flexible plastic ruler
- Old soft tooth brush
- Gunline pin holder **OR** 1/16" Dia. punch and hammer
- If needed Optivisor / magnifying glasses.
- Checkering Cradle. Brownells #080-026-000 The school may have some. Check with them.

Work Piece:

- Practice stock with pores filled. English Walnut preferred.
- I will be supplying flat practice blocks
