



Special Admit Students Grades 9-12
Steps to Enroll in College while attending High School

1. **Complete the online Application for Admissions- OpenCCC (Instructions are on the reverse side →)**
2. **Login in to MyLassen (the LCC Student Portal).** If you have any issues, please contact the Help Desk at 530-251-8844.
3. **Go to the website, www.lassencollege.edu.** Click on "**NEW STUDENTS**" under the picture. Click on "**NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION**" in Step 3. Enter your Lassen email address, and password, and complete the Orientation.
4. Meet with your High School Counselor to select college classes. Classes must be written on the Special Admit Form, with **Section Numbers Ex: (C4854)** and **Course Titles Ex: (Psy 1)**. The principal or designee from your school must sign the form authorizing you to enroll in college courses. **(Special Admit registration form is attached) ***
5. Your Parent or Legal Guardian must sign the Special Admit Form, giving permission for you as a High School Student to attend classes at LCC for the first time. Parents only need to sign the Special Admit form once while the student attends LCC. If the student attends multiple semesters, the initial signature acts as a blanket signature for approval on all classes. Parents must withdraw consent in writing.
6. **You are now ready to meet with a Counselor at Lassen Community College. You must bring your Special Admit Form for the Counselor to approve.** (Students enrolling in more than 6 units must obtain the Dean's signature after meeting with the college counselor.)
7. **When the above steps are complete, bring your signed Special Admit Form to the Admissions & Records Office to register for your classes.**
8. **Tuition is Free! There are No Student Fees!** You are only responsible for Materials Fees (Example - Art 36A = \$10 Materials Fee) and, of course, your books.



How to Complete the Online Application for Lassen Community College

1. Go to www.lassencollege.edu after you open the internet browser.
2. Click on **APPLY NOW** to begin the 2-step application process. *(First, create a user account, then sign-in, **then** sign-in to complete and submit the 9-part application.)*
3. Click on **CREATE AN ACCOUNT**.
4. Click on **BEGIN CREATING AN ACCOUNT** and fill in the boxes with your information.
5. You **MUST** enter your physical address, where it asks for Permanent Address.
6. Page 3 of 3, **Create a Username and Password** that you can easily remember.
7. Once you create your account, you will click the **Continue Button** and be taken to the Sign-In page. Sign-In with your newly created Username and Password.
8. Once you've signed in you will click on **Start a New Application**.
9. Under the **Account/Mailing Information** tab, you will see your information and at the bottom, **Current Mailing Address**. This is where you can add your mailing address, if it is different from your physical address.
10. If you attended a charter school (ex. Westwood Charter), you will click the **I Attended High School** option. The second and third option is for students that were taught at home by their parents.
11. At the end of the application, you will click on the **Submit My Application** button.
12. **Congratulations!** You have successfully completed and submitted your application to Lassen Community College! The next screen is confirmation that you submitted your application; keep a copy for your records.
