

DESCRIPTION

This course covers intermediate river and flood rescue skills, including shore-based methods, throw bag techniques, rope systems, and rescue watercraft. Students will learn hazard awareness, incident management, equipment use, victim search and rescue, technical rope skills, non-entry shore rescues, and incident termination. Certified to NFPA 1006 (2021) standards, it prepares participants for operational rescue roles. A supplemental fee of \$81 (including \$5 for materials) and a \$76 State Fire Training FSTEP certification fee are payable at registration to Lassen Community College.
