Follow-up discussion to nursing position from May 3 discussion:

The district is in desperate need of a temporary position to fill the person out on medical leave in the nursing department. However, there is need for a 3rd person in that department as well. It is going to be difficult to find a nurse going to apply for a part time or even temporary position. Employee will be hired on step 1-4 as determined by their qualifications as any other faculty member. The term of employment will start ASAP, be paid for summer teaching at the adjunct rate and then start on the regular calendar. What happened to the list of all the potential adjuncts we submitted to the state? Some are taking the ED class that is required prior to teaching. The committee was in consensus that immediate need should be addressed by hiring a full time temporary person with the potential for permanent hire. However, the permanent position needs further discussion.
