

- 1. Approve Meeting Agenda (Consultation) Karissa Morehouse/Cheryl Aschenbach-Approved by consensus.
- 2. Approve Meeting Minutes for November 5, 2018 (Consultation) Karissa Morehouse *Change wording to say reserve instead of just fund. Approved by consensus with the changes made.*
- 3. Accept Planning and Budget Development Handbook (Consultation) Cheryl Aschenbach- There were only a few edits to reinforce things that already exist. There were some edits and some clean up. Org charts need to be updated, there is a new version of the flow chart. On the calendar, in November (page 9), it says prioritize to Dean but it needs to say director. Decide if we are doing periods or no periods consistently throughout. Dr. Joslin's title will be checked throughout. Approved by consensus to move forward.
