6. **Discussion**

A. **Digital Graphic Design Program**

Proposal to add a new program with a transfer degree and certificate of achievement options to the existing program options at the college.

1. **Associate in Arts Degree University Studies: Emphasis in Digital Graphic Design**

*The committee recommendation is to make this a vocational degree in TOP code 1030.00 titled AS in Digital Graphic Design. Concern was expressed about the number of core units and the general education pattern presented was not CSU GE or IGETC requiring from 39-42 units. Discussion focused on the requirement for a portfolio to be produced by students expecting to earn a degree or certificate but not required of student not planning to earn the degree or certificate. Concern about tracking and students who change their minds were expressed. Also, concern about different treatment (expectations) for different populations of students was expressed. The goal of offering the Adobe certification test on campus for students was articulated. Lori Collier expressed her concern about maintaining standards and providing quality graduates from the program to the workforce. The Academic Services staff are researching the next meeting of the North/Far North Consortium. Approval from the consortium is required prior to submitting a new vocational program to the Chancellor's Office.*

2. **Digital Graphic Design Certificate of Achievement**

3. **Digital Media Arts Certificate of Achievement**

*This certificate is to be developed at a later date.*

B. **Art 22 – Digital Illustration**

Proposal to add a new 3 unit, 34-hour lecture and 51 hour laboratory course to the graphic design curriculum. The proposed course would be included in the core requirements for both AA degree and Certificate of Achievement.

*The course will be moved to action on the next agenda. Ms Mesloh will research articulation for the new courses to assure that the transfer numbers are appropriate.*

C. **Art 29 – Advanced Web Page Design**

Proposal to add a new 2 unit, 17-hour lecture and 51 hour laboratory course to the graphic design curriculum. The proposed course would be included as an elective in the AA degree and a core requirement for the Certificate of Achievement.

*The suggestion was to number this course Art 28 B parallel to the number of Art 60A and 60B. The course will be moved to action on the next agenda.*

**D. Art 60B – Advanced Production Graphics**

Proposal to add a new 2 unit, 17-hour lecture and 51 hour laboratory course to the graphic design curriculum. The proposed course would be included in the core requirements for both AA degree and Certificate of Achievement.

*The content of Art 60B is not significantly different from the content of Art 60A. It was suggested that Art 60A become the prerequisite to Art 60B.*

*The course will be moved to action on the next agenda pending the rewrite of the content.*

**F. AA-T Art History**

Proposal to add an associate for transfer degree in Art History

*The goals and objectives for the new transfer degree will be provided with the agenda item to consider adoption of the AA-T in Art History.*

**G. Art 9 – History of Asian Art**

Proposal to add a new art history course to meet one of the core requirements of the TMC for the AA-T in Art History
